- Express mail entries must include the signature waiver allowing them to be left at the secretary's address (max 10 entries per envelope). No entry shall be made, and no entry shall be accepted that specifies any conditions as to its acceptance. Online entries at MyDogEntry.com. **No entries will be accepted by phone, email or fax.**
 - Payment must accompany entry.** No hand deliveries will be accepted in the first twenty-four hours following the opening date and time. Inquiries may be directed to Shawna Richgels at CSZTrialSec@Gmail.com
- Entries must be submitted on Official AKC-form with correct entry-fees listed. One dog per form. **Please read the section: "Class changes effective January 1, 2020," posted in the premium, for instructions when entering same dog in multiple heights or mixed regular and preferred classes.**
- Agreement on back of form MUST be signed. Photo-copies must be legible with original signature. Max 10 entries (dogs) per envelope (includes Express-mail-entries). **NO emailed forms, fax or telephone entries accepted.**
- Illegible entries will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry and the Trial Secretary will add a \$30.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Be sure to include correct fees. Overpayments less than \$10 will not be refunded

Paper entries received within 24 hours of the opening date & time limit must:

- Include postage or be metered. No hand deliveries in the first 24 hours.
- Be delivered by a multi-state or multi-national postage or carrier service, including but not limited to USPS, FedEx, UPS & DHL. If above conditions are not met, the entries are not valid and must be returned to the sender.
- Express mail must be designated "no signature required".

Payment must accompany entry.

BIS will be ALLOWED to run in this trial, and may not wear panties, pants, or diapers at any time while on course. They will run in the original running order and must be started on a mat provided by the exhibitor. BIS will be required to wear panties in the building and have them removed right before entering the ring for their run.

Walk-through & Warm-up

Handlers in all classes will be permitted to walk the course without a dog prior to the start of the class. At the discretion of the judge, if the size of the entry for any class might inhibit a safe and fair walk-through by handlers, height divisions may be used to divide the walk-through into groups, e.g. walk-through for the 8", 12" and 16" division handlers followed by runs for those height divisions; then walk-through and subsequent runs for the 20" and 24" divisions. A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, will be provided.

OBSTACLES RING CONDITIONS

Course WALK-THROUGHS AND Warm-Up INFORMATION Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, during a walk-through period held prior to the start of the class. The walk-through is restricted to handlers entered in that class only.

A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, will be provided for exhibitors. The warm-up area is to be used exclusively for warming up the dog and not for training or relieving of the dog.

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

Obstacles

Obstacles shall meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of AKC Regulations for Agility Trials. **Tire will be set at FCI heights for 12", 16", 20" and 24" jump heights.** The FCI Long Jump will be used. The equipment for this event is provided by Canine Sports Zone

MIXED HEIGHT ENTRIES

Exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed. Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers With Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day. Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.

When calculating entry fees, treat multiple entry forms for the same dog as if only one form had been filled out. In other words, the 1st run entry fee is only paid once per day, per dog, even if that dog's runs have been submitted on multiple entry forms.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS FOR INTERNATIONAL SWEEPSTAKES CLASS (ISC)

Purpose: The International Sweepstakes Class (ISC) is a non-regular class providing the dog and handler an opportunity to demonstrate their advanced training and handling skills on various International Style Standard and Jumpers with Weaves courses. The rules for this class are generally based on international rules. The variety in International Agility course designs is very diverse, so handlers should be prepared to meet the "Challenge of the Day" when competing in the ISC class. The total challenge level may be easier, more difficult, or simply different from what is currently allowed in Excellent / Master Class. Complete rules for the ISC are available from the AKC Website (<https://www.akc.org>).

Eligibility: ISC classes are open to dogs that are eligible to compete in AKC agility trials. There is no Preferred Option for ISC; *dogs may enter at their preferred jump height, however they will be scored against the regular division dogs jumping the same jump height.*

Jump Heights: **DOGS MAY BE ENTERED IN THEIR REGULAR JUMP HEIGHTS**, however, only those dogs running in the 12", 16", 20" and 24" class that meet the FCI/ISC measuring cutoff (different than regular AKC cutoffs) may use their clean run toward the required qualification toward entering WTT or EOTT. Please see the 2022 EO/AWC Tryout Rules for further details.

The FCI/ISC cutoffs for those heights are as follows:

12" (Small) for dogs 13 ¾ inches and under at the withers
16" (Medium) for dogs over 13 ¾ inches and up to 16 7/8 inches at the withers
20" (Intermediate) for dogs over 16 7/8 inches but less than 18 7/8 inches at the withers
24" (Large) for dogs over 16.75 inches and under at the withers

ELIGIBILITY AND HEIGHT DIVISIONS

Dogs Eligible to Enter

This trial is open to all dogs 15 months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or are registerable breeds that have obtained PAL/ILP numbers from the American Kennel

Club, except aggressive dogs, blind dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. **Mixed breed dogs** listed in the AKC Canine Partners program are eligible to enter this all-breed AKC agility trial. Mixed breed dogs entered in these events must list the breed name as "Canine Partner" (mixed breed) and not as a breed hybrid and must include their AKC Canine Partners number on the entry form and check the AKC No. Box.

Jump Height Information

All dogs without height cards will have to be measured by the judge of record, except 24"/24C" dogs. If a VMO or an AKC Representative is available, all dogs without height cards, including 24"/24C" dogs, will need to be measured. When filling out the entry form, there is a new section at the top of the form for exhibitors to designate whether your dog has a valid jump height card or if your dog needs to be measured. Please check the appropriate box so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dogs on the *Dogs To Be Measured List*. For complete details on the Jump Height Card Process go to [this link](#) to read more about it on the AKC website

Eligible dogs may be entered in any level of ISC (Grade 1, 2, or 3). At present, there are no eligibility requirements for any level of ISC and any dog that is eligible according to the above information may run any level. Day of show level changes are not allowed.

EO/ WORLD TEAM TRYOUT QUALIFICATIONS

Clear ISC Agility (Standard) and JWW (Jumpers With Weaves) rounds from any level can be used to fulfill the requirements for the [Team USA European Open Team Tryouts](#). Clear rounds from Levels 2 and 3 can be used to fulfill the requirements for [Team USA Agility World Championships Tryouts](#). Dogs must jump at their international height for ISC scores to count toward Tryouts Qualifications.

VOLUNTEER INFORMATION

We need your HELP for a Successful Trial!

We rely on the generosity of agility enthusiasts to pitch in and help keep the trial running smoothly and efficiently. Those of you who are experienced can help us by sharing your talents and helping to train the newcomers. For those of you who are new to agility, we will train you and offer support as you learn about what it takes to put on a trial.

SITE INFORMATION AND RULES

The show site is indoors on artificial turf. Please bring your own crate, clean up supplies, & water for your dog. Dogs must be kept on leash when not in the ring, except when in the fenced off leash area. A warm up area is

available in a special stall in the crating area that has been turfed and has a warm up jump in it.

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Trial Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. *Please NO SPIKE SHOES OR HEELS on the turf. Please wear/use clean, athletic footwear to preserve the flooring!*

ENTERING FOR EXHIBITION ONLY (FEO)

FEO allows exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. FEO is offered in all classes. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.

FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.

- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.
- Handler has 45 Seconds for Standard, JWW, and Time 2 Beat classes (course time in FAST). Exhibitors must quickly move towards the exit when the horn sounds.
- Dogs may be entered in any level (Novice, Open, Excellent, Master). If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed.
- The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out. FEO may be declared earlier (ex. when checking in at the gate board).
- Toys are allowed in the ring. Toys must be non-audible and may not leave the handlers hand. Toys that roll freely may not be used.
- Food/treats are not allowed in the ring
- FEO should be utilized for the benefit of the dog and not as a punitive correction. Harsh verbal and/or physical corrections shall not be tolerated. Any determination of harshness by the judge shall be immediately whistled and the handler will be dismissed from the ring.
- A judge must monitor the entire run. Judges can stop a run at any time

FIX AND GO ON (FNG)

Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the course of the run. FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score.

AWARDS, RIBBONS AND PRIZE INFORMATION

Awards

Awards for qualifying scores only. All awards must be claimed at the show. Ribbons will be awarded to first through fourth place in each height division in each class.

Special prizes

Spring Fever Cup Final. ISC Agility 2 on Sunday will be designated as the "Spring Fever Cup Final", with special prizes for 1st - 3rd place in each jump height. Preferred dogs will jump at the lower height but compete along their regular height peers for the special prizes in the Final. Any dog entered in this class is eligible for 1st-4th place rosettes, however only dogs that qualified for Final will be eligible for the special prizes. Dogs qualify for the special awards in Final by placing in the top 50% of any of the other classes on Saturday or Sunday. An elimination result does not count for top 50% placement in any class. Dog must be entered in Final to be able to run in it.

EXHIBITOR INFORMATION

Important Information for Exhibitors

- All owners and handlers are responsible for correctly entering and participating in this trial in accordance with AKC rules. Owners are responsible for errors in entry forms, regardless of who may make such errors.
- All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area. AKC does not permit pinch/prong collars, electrical or special training collars anywhere on the trial grounds.
- The safety of dogs is of primary concern. By entering the trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of the AKC agility program, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- Confirmation of entry and a schedule of judging time will be sent to the address (email will be used when provided on the entry form) on the official AKC entry form after the closing date. If an exhibitor has not received a copy of the schedule at least seven days prior to the show, the trial secretary should be contacted. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. If a check is returned, the entry will be deemed invalid, and the issuer will be billed for all trial associated fees, including, but not limited to: AKC fees, judges fees and secretarial fees. **Envelopes/transactions containing entries for more than the ten (10) dog maximum shall be treated as an invalid entry.**
- Conditional, unsigned, incomplete, illegible, telephone or telegraph entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on official AKC forms or photocopies of AKC forms without the agreement form included are not acceptable.
- 100% of entry fees will be refunded if a **written request is received by the trial secretary on or before the trial closing date.** After closing, refunds will be given, if notification is received not less than 48 hours prior to the start of the trial, less all fees, for injured or ill handlers, injured or ill dogs. No refunds will be given if request is received after the published commencement of the trial. Verification from a doctor or vet may be required at the club's discretion. No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, acts of God, public emergency, acts of public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- MIAC of WI, Shawna Richgels, and Canine Sports Zone assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or spectators, or to any of their dogs or property, and further assumes no responsibility for injury to any child not under the control of his or her parents or guardians.
- MIAC of WI may cancel this event in extreme weather conditions.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area.
- Please clean up after your dogs while on the show grounds and at the motel site. We want to retain these facilities for future events.
- Only dogs that are eligible to be shown under the AKC rules shall be allowed within the show precincts.

DIRECTIONS

From the North: Take the US-12 south toward Madison. Take the Airport Rd exit (EXIT250) toward Century Ave/County Hwy M. Turn left onto Airport Rd. Turn right onto Laura Ln. Continue to 3036 Laura Ln on the right.

From the South: I-90 W toward Rockford/ I-294 N/Milwaukee. Merge onto US-12 W/W Beltline Hwy W via EXIT 142A on the left toward Madison. Take the Airport Rd exit (EXIT250) toward Century Ave/County Hwy M. Turn right onto Century Ave. Turn right onto Laura Ln. Continue to 3036 Laura Ln on the right.

From the East: From Milwaukee take I-94 West. Keep left to take WI-30 toward Madison/Janesville. Merge onto US-12 W/W Beltline Hwy W via EXIT 142A toward Madison. Take the Airport Rd exit (EXIT250) toward Century Ave/County Hwy M. Turn right onto Century Ave. Turn right onto Laura Ln. Continue to 3036 Laura Ln on the right

WAIT LIST

Wait List for Withdrawn Entries after the Closing Date/Time: MIAC is offering a Wait List to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the trial's closing date/time. A maximum of 50 runs will be placed on the club's wait list. All entries, including wait listed entries, must be received by the Trial Secretary prior to March 11th, 2026, at 6:00PM. Any entries withdrawn by March 15, 2026, at 6:00PM will be replaced by a wait listed entry if any are available. If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a wait listed entry, a full refund will be issued for the withdrawn entry. Any wait listed entry that does not move off the wait list into the trial will receive a full refund.

Checks for entry fees will be held until March 16th, 2026. If the event cannot be held, checks will be shredded.

If we cannot hold the event after entry fee checks have been deposited, then refunds will be sent once all funds have cleared the bank.
